Legalization of documents issued by Jamaican authorities

Please bear in mind that some procedures before this Consulate and other Colombian entities require that documents issued by Foreign authorities are apostilled/legalized and translated to Spanish.

For Jamaica, you must legalize the document completing the so-called legalization chain as follows:

- Take the document and follow the procedure before the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Foreign Trade of Jamaica. Please verify the information and costs in the following link: <u>https://mfaft.gov.jm/jm/authentication-and-legalisation-of-documents/</u>
- 2. Once you have completed this step, you can come to the consulate to authenticate the signature of the MFAFT authority. This procedure costs 22 USD. Please note that currently this Consular office is only attending by appointment.
